℞ And dwelt among us.

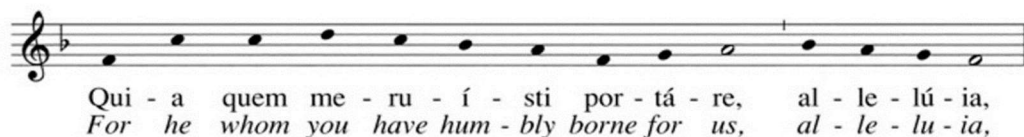
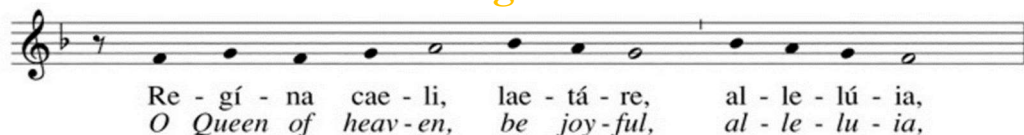
Hail Mary . . .

℞ That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

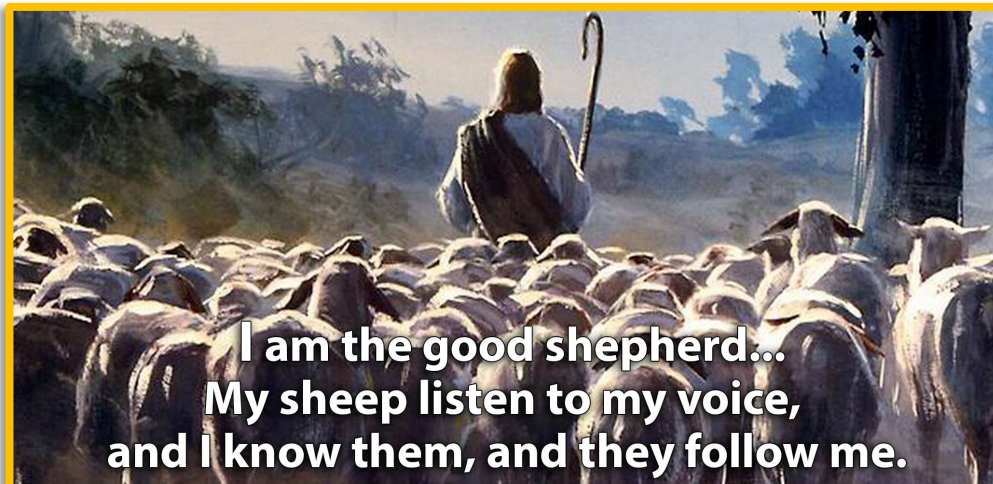
